### **LIFE UNIVERSITY BUSINESS PROFESSORS PRESENT AT DECA STATE CAREER DEVELOPMENT CONFERENCE**

**Marietta, Georgia, February 4, 2020** – [Life University](http://www.LIFE.edu) (LIFE) was one of the sponsors of the Georgia DECA State Career Development Conference January 30-February 1, 2020 at the Hyatt Regency Atlanta. LIFE Adjunct Professor of Business Dr. Marla Thompson, Assistant Professor of Business and Business Program Coordinator Marie A. Powell and Assistant Professor of Business Ronald G. Ware also gave presentations on leadership during the three-day event.

This was the first year that Life University sponsored the conference, which provided an opportunity for students from around Georgia to compete among the best in the state in the competitive events program and executive officer elections. Students also participated in leadership workshops and trainings.

[DECA Inc.](http://www.deca.org), formerly Distributive Education Clubs of America, is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit career and technical student organization with more than 228,000 members in all 50 U.S. states, Washington, D.C., Puerto Rico, Guam and five international countries. Its mission is to prepare high school and college students for careers in marketing, finance, hospitality and management.

Powell's presentation, "Marketing: The Blue Ocean Effect," described a theory that categorizes current industries as "red oceans" and potential future industries as "blue oceans." The concept allows students to think more creatively, Powell said.

"Companies are looking for people to come up with innovative ideas beyond just thinking about what's happening with competition," Powell said. "Businesses want employees to be much more innovative and to really find out what's missing from the marketplace."

Dr. Thompson's presentation, "Mainstream to Magnificent," concentrated on authentic assessments of performance in which individuals demonstrate their skills and knowledge. She used popular examples like Shark Tank, the NCAA's March Madness tournament and the Super Bowl.

Ware said he was initially interested in participating in the DECA conference because his daughter was a member of the organization for three years during high school. His presentation, "Leadership Today and Beyond," focused on the attributes and behaviors that successful leaders share and on how people experience leadership.
