Most sessions will take place in [The Commons](#), LIFE's newest residence hall. Designated for first-year students only, The Commons is a physical example of a living-learning community created to encourage student integration and social collaboration. Located on the southwest side of campus, the building features approximately 100,000 sq. ft. of living space for up to 360 residents as well as the Lyceum Dining Hall. Group gathering and study areas are located on each floor.

Eagle Madness is held every spring and fall, with the next event scheduled for November 12-13. Similarly, [LIFE Leadership Weekend](#) is a preview event for prospective chiropractic students that takes place four times a year, including April 15-17 and July 22-24, 2021. Individual and group tours for prospective undergraduate, graduate and chiropractic students take place every week.
